Reporting and Communicating

SLA keeps all staff members informed and up to date about new safety measures and risk reduction for communicable disease.

Staff and Instructors direct any safety concerns related to communicable disease to CFI (Akiko Takami, aki@sealandair.ca)

- CFI is the person responsible to contact local and provincial public health authorities regarding communicable disease outbreak and any compliance issues.
- CFI and Assistant CFIs monitor risks in collaboration with staff and instructors, and updates measures as needed.

Prevention Measures

- Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) Policy
Wearing a facemask (either Non-surgical or surgical) in SLA facility is recommended but optional. Safety in flight should not be diminished by the pilots' use of PPE. Check if your voice through your facemask has enough readability on the intercom before and after starting engine.

COVID-19

If you tested COVID-19 positive you are required to isolate yourself.

You can end isolation when all three of these conditions are met:

1. At least **5 days** have passed since your symptoms started, or from test date if you did not have symptoms.
2. Fever has resolved without the use of fever-reducing medication, such as acetaminophen or ibuprofen.
3. Symptoms have improved.

Guide for International Students

However, as a result of the COVID-19 Pandemic, there are some important protocols that international students must follow to reduce the risk of infection and transmission of the virus.

Please take some time to review the [most updated travel restrictions and policies by Canadian government](#). Not following the most updated travel restrictions and policies by Canadian government to enter Canada can result in a denial of entry into the country. Government authorities may also fine students for non-compliance in certain situations.

Please confirm that you understand and agree with the following by placing check mark (✓) on each.

- I understand that I have a sole responsibility to check and follow the most updated travel restrictions and policies by Canadian government to enter Canada.
- I am aware of the requirement to comply with the Government of Canada's [Quarantine Act](#) and violating any instructions and requirements laid out under *Quarantine Act* will be reported to the RCMP, provincial and local Police, and resulting the penalties of violation of the *Quarantine Act*, which include up to 6 months in prison and/or \$750,000.00 in fines.

- I confirm that I have appropriate medical insurance, effective as of the date of my arrival in Canada, which includes coverage of COVID-19.
